To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Ralph Peterson, of Greenville County.

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Six Thousand, Two Mundred and no/100 - - - - -

(\$ 6,200.00) Dollars, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the monthly payments set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by reason of said advances, with interest at the rate specified in said note,

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and being at Slater, being known and designated as Lot No. 1, Block 0, as shown on a plat thereof made by Pickell and Pickell, Engineers, Greenville, S. C., February 25, 1952, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book LL at page 3, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Talley Bridge Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 2, S. 32-47 E. 300 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 57-13 W. 183.3 feet to an iron pin on the Northeastern side of a 15-foot alley; thence with the Northeastern side of said alley N. 26-27 W. 302 feet to an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Talley Bridge Road; thence with the Southeastern side of Talley Bridge Road, N. 57-13 E. 150 feet to the point of beginning; and being the same property conveyed to Ralph Peterson and Sarah W. Peterson by deed dated March 14, 1957, not yet recorded."
