

sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Pelzer-Williamston Bank, its successors and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Beginning at an iron pin in the center of a public road at the corner of the property of Paul Roaches and running thence along his line, S. 80 W. 815 feet to an iron pin at a white oak at the corner of the Paul Roach property, (formerly Kelly); thence along the line of that property, S. 65 W. 800 feet to a point in the center of Saluda river; thence along the river as the line S. 32 E. 300 feet to a bend; thence S. 8-30 E. 378 feet to an iron pin on the bank of a branch as the corner of Doyle McKee's land; thence along his line S. 80 E. 191 feet to an iron pin; thence still with McKee's line, N. 85 E. 99 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 59 3/4 E. 693 feet to an iron pin; thence still with McKee's line N. 75 3/4 E. 397 feet to an iron pin in the center of an old-cut road, thence with the old dirt road to the point where it intersects with the public road; thence along the center of the public road to the beginning corner.
