NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Butler Township, on the northwest side of Simmons Avenue, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lots No. 199 and 200 on plat of East Lynne Addition, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May 1933, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H at Page 220, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit: LOT 199: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Simmons Avenue at the joint corner of Lots 198-199 and running thence with the joine line of said lots N. 42-30 W. 212.5 feet to an iron pin in line of property of H. A. Rouch; thence with said Rouch line S. 36-43 W. 50.9 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of Lots 199-200; thence with joint line of the last mentioned lots S. 42-30 E. 203 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Simmons Avenue; thence with said Simmons Avenue N. 47-30 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagors by deed recorded in Deed Book 310, Page 230. LOT 200: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Simmons Avenue at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 199 and 200, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 199, N. 42-30 W. 203 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 36-43 W. 50.9 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 201 S. 42-30 E. 193.5 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Simmons Avenue; thence along the northwest side of Simmons Avenue N. 47-30 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same premises conveyed to Alma S. Morris and O. G. Morris by deed dated February 24, 1947, recorded in Deed Book 308, Page 98, the said Alma S. Morris having conveyed her one-half interest to Ovel G. Morris (same as O. G. Morris) by deed recorded in Deed Book 313, Page 408.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
