Dollars (\$13,500.00), with interest from date at the rate of five & one-fourth centum (5½ %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of the Loan Guaranty Officer, Veterans Administration Regional Office, at Columbia, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Seventy-Four and 56/100 --- Dollars (\$74.56), commencing on the 18th day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sconer paid, shall be due and payable on the 18th day of August , 1890.

Now, Know All Man, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, and unto his successors in such office, as such, and his or their assigns, the following described property, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, on the Southwest corner of the intersection of Fleetwood Drive and Cool Brook Drive, shown as Lot No. 54 on Plat of Magnolia Acres recorded in Plat Book GG, at page 133, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and being more particularly shown on Plat of property of Cornelius Hammett Dearybury, dated June 8, 1960, and, according to said Plat, being more particularly described as follows:
