NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and furthersums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his accont by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Grove Township, on Southwest side of Augusta Road, about five (5) miles from the City of Greenville, being Lot 4 on plat by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, September 1949and described as follows: BEGINNING at iron pin on Augusta Road, joint front corner of lots 3 and 4, thence with line of lot 3 North 87-15 West 387.5 feet to iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 3 and 4, thence North 14-23 East 126.3 feet to iron pin in line of lands of Thomas Stenhouse, thence South 85-50 East 336.3 feet to iron pin on Augusta Road, thence with sothwest side of said road South 9-40 East 119 feet to the beginning.

The foregoing land was conveyed to mortgagor by deed of Thomas Stenhouse, August 16, 1961, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County in Deed Book 681 at page 7.
