All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township,, situated on the west side of a County road near its intersection with the Old Greenville-Spartanburg Road near Pleasant Grove Baptist Church, containing 1.26 acres, more or less, and shown on the plat of the property of Ralph W. and Hubert F. Mullinax by H.S. Brockman, Registered Surveyor, dated October 10, 1950, recorded in Plat Book 00, pages 140-141, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:
