All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Southern side of Greer Drive, in Butler Township, containing 6.65 acres; and having according to a plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated February 6, 1957 entitled "Survey for Carolina Concrete Pipe Co., Inc. near Mauldin, S. C." and reworded in the R.M.C.
