We, W. E. Coleman and Thelma C. Coleman

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said W. E. Coleman and Thelma C. Coleman

in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date with these Presents, are well and truly indebted unto the CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., in the full and just sum of

Four thousand five hundred and no/100 - - - (\$ 4,500.00) Dollars,

with interest from the date hereof at the rate of seven per cent (7 %) per annum, unpaid interest to bear interest at the same rate, to be repaid in installments of

Forty-nine and 25/100 - - - - - (\$ 49.25) dollars due and payable on the 5th day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest and all costs, insurance, and expenses incurred in connection with said loan, has been paid, said monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, and then to payment of principal, costs, expenses and insurance, if any, incurred; and said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due hereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of sixty (60) days, or upon failure to comply with any of the by-laws of said Association, or with any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall at the option of the holder become immediately due and payable, and said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed with an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we the said W. E. Coleman and Thelma C. Coleman, in consideration of the said debt and sums of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to us the said mortgagor, in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, containing FIVE (5) acres more or less and being a part of Tract No. 1 of the property of Thad E. Sammons, plat of which is recorded in plat book V page 196, Greenville County E. M. C. Office, and according to said plat has the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a nail and stopper in the center of the intersection of the Neece Bridge Road with a dirt road, known as Batson Road, and running thence with the South side of said Batson Road N. 71-10 W., 137.5 feet to a bend; thence still with said road (South side) S. 72-41 E., 300 feet; thence S. 14-30 E., 676 feet more or less, to the center of Buck Horn Creek; thence with the center of said creek as the line N. 89 E., 75 feet, more or less to bend; thence still with said creek N. 85-45 E., 240 feet to a bend; thence N. 49-30 E., 160 feet to the center of Neece Bridge Road; thence up and with the center of said road the following courses and distances, to wit: N. 1-30 W., 80 feet; N. 11-74 E., 100 feet, N. 14-40 E., 100 feet; N. 0-15 W., 100 feet, N. 5-05 W., 100 feet; N. 33-30 W., 277.8 feet more or less to the point of beginning. This is the same property conveyed to Cleveland Nicholson by Missouri E. Pollard by her deed recorded in deed book 615 page 39, Greenville County R. M. C. Office.

AND that certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, near Piedmont Park and Piedmont Avenue and south therefrom, lying on the south and west side of a new street which leads from Piedmont Avenue, bounded on the north by H. P. Hanley's lot, on the east and west by other lands of W. E. Coleman and Thelma C. Coleman, and on the south by W. E. Young, and Milo M. Young, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING on an iron pin, the southwest corner of Hanley's lot and runs thence S. 1-15 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on Young's line; thence with the Young line, N. 81-55 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-15 E. 200 feet to an iron pin, the southeastern corner of Hanley's lot; thence with the Hanley line, S. 71-30 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner, this being the same lot conveyed to Louise W. McAdams by W. E. Coleman and Thelma C. Coleman by deed of August 5, 1920, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 657 at page 452.
