"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, being known and designated as the major portion of Lot No. 149 of a subdivision known as Orchard Acres, Section Two, as shown on a plat of a portion of said subdivision prepared by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, March, 1960, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at page 6, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Northway Drive, joint front corner of Lots 149 and 150 and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 5-20 E. 160 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 84-40 W. 115 feet to an iron pin; thence with a new line along the line of property now owned by Arthur Miller, Jr., S. 4-48 W. 168 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Northway Drive (which iron pin lies S. 88-31 E. 33.8 feet from the original joint front corner of Lots 148 and 149); thence with the northern side of Northway Drive, S. 88-31 E. 115 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to us by Arthur P. Campbell by deed of even date to be recorded herewith."

In addition to the above mentioned monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, the mortgagor (s) agree (s) to pay to the mortgagee on the first day of each month until the note secured by this instrument is fully paid, the following sums: a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes, and assessments next due on the mortgaged property (all as estimated by the mortgagee) less all sums already paid therefor, divided by the number of months to elapse before one month prior to the date when such premiums, taxes, and assessments will be due and payable, such sums to be held by mortgagee in escrow to pay said premiums, taxes and special assessments. Should these payments exceed the amount of payments actually made by the mortgagee for taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums, the excess may be credited by the mortgagee on subsequent payments to be made by the mortgagor (s); if, however, said sums shall be insufficient to make said payments when the same shall become due and payable, the mortgagor (s) shall pay to the mortgagee any amounts necessary to make up the deficiency.
