NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs

Township, on the south side of Woodland Drive in the City of Green, and being Lot No. 20 of a subdivision known as PINEBROOK, according to survey and plat by H.S. Brockman, Registered Surveyor, dated February 21, 1955, recorded in Plat Book FF, page 290, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances: BEGINNINGM at an iron pin on the south side of Woodland Drive, corner of Lots Nos. 19 and 20 and running thence along the line of said lots, S. 52-50 W. 206 feet to branch; thence up said branch, S. 22-20 E. 68 feet and S. 49-19 E. 142.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 78-08 E. 153 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 9-30 W. 237 feet to Woodland Drive; thence along said Drive in a curving line, N. 73-48 W. 76.1 feet to the beginning corner.

ALSO, a strip of land on the south side of Woodland Drive adjoining Lot No. 20, having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING at the intersection of Ashmore Street and Woodland Drive, and running thence along said Drive, S. 80-44 W. 194 feet to the corner of Lot No. 20; thence along the line of Lot No. 20, S. 9-30 E. 22.2 feet to a stake; thence N. 80-05 E. 194 feet to Ashmore Street; thence along said Street, N. 9-45 W. 20 feet to the beginning corner.
