NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor man be independed to the Mortgage at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Butler Township, being a portion of lots Nos. 14 & 15, on plat of Rodgers Valley Heights, recorded in plat book GG at page 103 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Howell Circle, which pin is 135.3 feet N. 68-32 W. from the front joint corner of Lots 13 and 14; thence with the northern side of Howell Circle, N. 68-32 W. 225 feet to an iron pin in the front line of lot No. 15; thence with a new line through said lot N. 21-28 E. 188 feet to an iron pin in the center of right of way; thence with the center of said right of way N. 85-49 E. 121.5 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of lot No. 14; thence with a new line through said lot S. 16-26 W. 285 feet to the beginning corner on the northern side of Howell Circle.
