TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: BOBBY JOE BAYNE

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of TEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100THS- DOLLARS (\$ 10,500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid in monthly instalments of SEVENTYFIVE AND NO/100THS- Dollars (\$ 75.00) each on the first day of each month hereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid; each payment to be applied first to payment of interest and then to payment of principal, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the eastern side of Razor Drive, shown as the northern one-half of Lot No. 3 and the southern one-half of Lot No. 2 on a plat entitled Property of F. B. Talley, recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County in Plat Book CC at Page 105, and being shown further on a survey entitled Property A. M. Harper, prepared by C. O. Riddle, R.L.S., dated April 7, 1962, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Razor Drive at a point 977.6 feet in a southerly direction from the intersection of Razor Drive and Woodland Drive, which point is in the line of Lot No. 2 and running thence through Lot No. 2, S. 71-17 E. 260 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 7; thence along the lines of Lots Nos. 7 and 6, S. 18-43 W. 100 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lots Nos. 6 and 3; thence in a line through Lot No. 3, N. 71-17 W. 260 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Razor Drive; thence along Razor Drive, S. 18-43 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by Albert M. Harper

The Mortgagor agrees that after the expiration of ten years from the date hereof, the Mortgagee may at its option apply for mortgage insurance for an additional period of five years with the mortgage insurance company insuring this loan, and the Mortgagor agrees to pay to the Mortgagee as premium for such insurance one-half of one per cent of the principal balance then existing.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
