NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagor at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its

Mall that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the south side of Montclair Avenue (formerly Fairview Avenue), in the City of Greenville, being lot 12 and the western one-shalf of lot 13 of Block F, on plat of Highland Terrace made by W. J. Riddle, in October 1936, recorded in Plat Book K at Page 121, and described as Follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the south side of Montclair Avenue, 100.4 feet east from Water Street, at corner of lot 11, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 21-00 W. 151.3 feet to a stake; thence with S. 70-00 E. 43.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 65-27 E. 25 feet to a stake at corner of property now or formerly owned by Cora H.
