reference, in the sum of Three Thousand One Hundred and No/100

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Town of Fountain Inn, being known and designated as Lot No. 18 on Woodland Drive Woodland Heights and being more fully described in accordance with plat made of Woodland Heights dated May, 1954 by Lewis C. Godsey and recorded in Plat Book "EE", Page 101, to-wit:
