Alexander, Jr., of Greenville County, SEND GREETINGS: WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-VILLE, in the full and just sum of Nineteen Thousand and No/100 ----- (\$.19.000.00) Dollars (or for future advances which may be made hereunder at the option of said Association, which advances shall not exceed the maximum amount stated herein and shall be evidenced by a subsequent promissory note or notes secured hereby), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate specified therein in installments of One Hundred Twenty-Two and 42/100 --- (\$ 122, 42) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid, such monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal.
