NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor(s) paid by the said Mortgagee at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee, The First National Bank of Greer, its Successors and Assigns:

All that parcel or lot of land in Oneal Towship, Greenville County, South Carolina, located about three miles northwest of the City of Greer, being shown and designsted as Lot No. 16 on a plat of subdivision known as VALLEYHAVEN made by W. Dennis Smith by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated July 22, 1959, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on an iron pin on Haven Drive, joint corner of Lots Nos. 15 and 16 on said plat and runs thence with the common line of Lots Nos. 15 and 16, S. 0-15 E. 196.8 feet to a point on line of the John and Jane Greer Estate lands (iron pin back on a line at 5.2 feet); thence with the line of that property, N. 89-40 W. 326 feet to a point in center of branch; (iron pin on east bank of branch); thence down the branch as the line, N. 21-10 E. 80 feet and N. 6-10 E. 190 feet to point in branch (iron pin on east bank thereof); torner of Lot No. 17; thence N. 89-45 E. 219 feet to an iron pin on Haven Drive; thence along and with the margin of Haven drive in a southeasterly direction (curving) about 116.8 feet to the beginning.
