NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mertgages, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgager in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby adknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgages, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Oaklawn Township, containing three and twentyseven and one-hundredths (3.27) acres, more or less, as shwon by plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor. REGINNING at C. C. Allen's corner, and having metes and bounds as follows: S. 9 W. 452 feet bounded by C. C. Allen; N. 70-25 391 feet feet, bounded by State Highway No. 8; N. 25 E. 448 feet bounded by estate of N. Carrie Newton, S. 69 E. 250 feet, bounded by estate land of I. P. Jordan.

Newton pro perty; thence along line of said Newton property N. 23-0 E. 318.7 feet to iron pin; thence S. 82-0 E. 177 feet to iron pin corner of Broadus C. White property; thence along line of said White property S. 23-0 W. 353 feet to the point of beginning.

This being a portion of the property conveyed to me by the heirs of Carrie N. Newton and the same lot of land conveyed to me by H. H. Newton by deed dated July 24, 1945, and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 278, at page 166.

Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenences to the same belonging in any way incident or apertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had thereform, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein.
