All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being at the northeasterly corner of the intersection of West McBee Avenue and South Laurens Street, in the City of Greenville, S. C., and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northeasterly corner of the intersection of West McBee Avenue and South Laurens Street, and running thence with the edge of West McBee Avenue S 70-45 E 100 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running N 18-15 E 98 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running N 70-45 W 100 feet to an iron pin on the easterly side of South Laurens Street; thence turning and running with the easterly side of South Laurens Street S 18-15 W 98 feet to the point of beginning.
