Crain and his heirs and assigns:

All of that parcel or lot of land in Highland Township of Green-ville County, South Carolina, situate on the northeast side of the Few's Bridge Road, between Mountain View and Few's Chapel Church, containing one acre, more or less, bounded on the north by lands of Donald Crain and lands formerly owned by Jim Few, on the south and east by King Bramlett and Gravely, and on the west by Gravely and Donald Crain, having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on an iron pin on the northeast side of said road, and runs thence N. 47 E. 4.28 to an iron pin on old Bramlett line; thence N. 12-30 E. 3.35 chains to a pin in the Morgan line; thence S. 47 W. 6.85 chains to an iron pin on the edge of said road; thence along said road, S. 37-30 E. 1.88 chains to the beginning.
