I am an Assistant Secretary of Liberty Life Insurance Company and am associated with the Mortgage Loan Department. In this capacity I have access to our mortgage loan records.

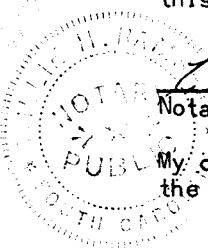
According to our mortgage loan records, on September 21, 1962 Greenville Motor Lodges, Inc., a South Carolina corporation with its principal place of business at Greenville, South Carolina, made and executed a promissory note in the original amount of \$345,000.00 payable to Liberty Life Insurance Company with instalments of \$2,911.80 payable monthly over a period of 15 years, which instalments are applied first to interest at 6% and then to principal. On the same date in order to secure said promissory note, said Greenville Motor Lodges, Inc. made and executed a certain mortgage which covered, in addition to real estate located in Greenville County, South Carolina, personal property consisting of the furniture, fixtures, furnishings and other personal property located upon said real estate and used in the operation of the motel. On September 21, 1962, the mortgage was recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County, S. C., in Mortgage Book 901, at page 571. Liberty Life Insurance Company is still the owner and holder of said note and mortgage on which there is now due a balance of Two Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Nine and 09/100 (\$299,729.09) Dollars with interest from September 1, 1965 at the rate of 6% per annum payable monthly.
