Now, Know All Men, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville

State of South Carolina; on the western side of Lanneau Drive and being known and designated as Lot No. 57 and part of Lot No. 58 as shown on plat of Lanneau Drive Highlands, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "D", Page 289 and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Lanneau Drive, said pin being 657 feet north of the intersection of Lanneau Drive and East Faris Road and running thence N. 79-49 W. 150 feet; thence S. 10-11 W. 62.5 feet; thence S. 79-49 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Lanneau Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 56 and 57; thence with the western side of Lanneau Drive N. 10-11 E. 62.5 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
