R. M. C. MORTGAGE RELEASE

WHEREAS on February 8, 1965, T. C. Abbott and Ivy B. Abbott executed and delivered their promissory note to Barco, Inc. in the original amount of Forty-two Hundred Sixty-two and 29/100 Dollars (\$4262.29) and in order to secure said indebtedness executed and delivered on the same date to said creditors their real estate mortgage covering the real estate hereinafter described, said mortgage being recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. office in Vol. 985, at page 532; and,

WHEREAS, subsequently the said Barco, Inc. assigned the aforementioned note and mortgage to the North American Acceptance Corporation who is now the owner and holder of same,

NOW THEREFORE KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that the North American Acceptance Corporation, for a valuable consideration paid to it by the Laurens Federal Savings and Loan Association, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby release and forever discharge from the lien of the aforementioned mortgage the property hereinafter described, preserving, however, all of its rights as holder of the aforementioned note, the terms and conditions of which shall remain of full force and effect.

The property hereby released is described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Woodside Mills Village, in Simpsonville, being Lot 117 on plat by Piedmont Engineering Service, February 1953, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County in PlatBook GG at page 5. Said lot is also known as 14 Second Street and fronts thereon for 79 feet.

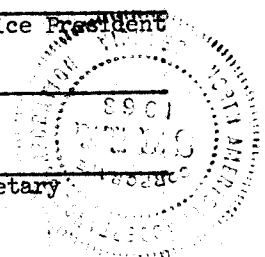
