"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, on the western side of Holliday Ave., near the city of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 11 on plat of property of A. W. Holliday, made by R. E. Dalton in October, 1923, recorded in the plat book F at page 167, and described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the western side of Holliday Avenue 114 feet south from Morgan Street, at corner of Lot No. 10, and running thence with the line of said lot, S.83-15W. 120 feet to a stake; thence \$.6-45 E. 57 feet to a stake at corner of lot No. 12; thence with the line of said lot N. 83-15E. 120 feet to a stake on Holliday Avenue; thence with the western side of Holliday Avenue N.6-45 W. 57 feet to the beginning corner.
