ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land lying on the Southwestern side of Oak Drive, near Anderson Road, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 2 on a Plat of the Property of Henry C. Harding . Builders, Inc., made by Campbell & Clarkson, Surveyors, dated July 12, 1967, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book PPB, page 95, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:
