NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, located near St. Mark M. E. Church (Colored) lying on the south side of the road that leads from Loftis' Packing Shed to J. W. Greer's Store, being shown and designated as Lot No. 3 on a plat of property of James H. Priestly Estate made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, October 23, 1947, and having the following courses and distances to wit:

BEGINNING on a point in the center of the said road, joint corner of Lots 2 and 3 (Iron pin on the south bank of the Road) and runs thence with the dividing Line of Lots 2 and 3 S. 19-36 W. 766 feet to a stake on the line of Lot No. 6; thence with the dividing line of Lots 3 and 6 N. 63-40 E. 240 feet to a stake on the said line and joint corner of Lots 3 and 4; thence with the dividing line of Lots 3 and 4 N. 16-18 E. 613 feet to a point in the center of the said road (iron pin back on line on the south bank of the road); thence with the center of the said road N. 82-20 W. 130 feet to the beginning corner, and containing two and twenty five one-hundredths (2.25) Acres, More or less.
