"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in or near the City Of Greenville, with improvements thereon situate, and being more particularly described as Lot No. 42, Section "C" as shown on a plat entitled " A Subdivision Of Woodside Mills, Greenville, South Carolina" made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, Greenville, South Carolina, January 14, 1950 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office For Greenville County in Plat Book "W" at pages 111 through 117 inclusive. According to said plat, the within described lot is also known as Lot No. 62, East Seventh Street and fronts thereon 59 feet.
