MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

ALL that lot of land with improvements thereon, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Northwestern side of Cottingham Circle (formerly Cottingham Street) and being known and designated as Lot No. 36 on a Plat of Monaghan Subdivision recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book GG, pages 86 and 87, reference to which is hereby craved for the metes and bounds thereof.

The within mortgage in junior in lien to a first mortgage on said property in favor of the Veterans Administration in the original sum of \$10,000.00 recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Mortgage Book 1105, page 640.

Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
