default, the Mortgagee shall apply, at the time of the commencement of such proceedings, or at the time the property is otherwise acquired, the balance then remaining in the funds accommisted under (b) of paragraph 2 proceeding, as a credit against the amount of principal then remaining unpubli under the note secured hereby, and shall properly adjust any payments which shall have been made under (a) of paragraph 2.

- 4. That he will pay all taxes, assessments, water rates, and other governmental or sunicipal changes, fines, or impositions, for which provision has not been sade hereinbefore, and is default thereof the Bodrgages may he same; and that he will promptly deliver the official acceptate therefore to the Bodrgages. If the Modrgages fails to make any payments provided for in this section or any other payments for taxes, assessments, or the like, the Modrgages may pay the same, and all summ so paid shall beer interest at the rate set forth in the note secured hereby from the date of such otrance and shall be secured by this modrgage.
- 5. That he will keep the premises in as good order and condition as they are now and will not commit or permit any waste thereof, reasonable wear and test excepted.
- 6. That he will keep the improvements now existing or hescafter exected on the mortgaged property insused as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and other lazards, casualties not contingencies in such amounts and for such periods as may be required by the Mortgagee and will pay promptly, when due, any premiums on such insurance provision for payment of which has not been made hereinbefore. That he hereby assigns all the rents, issues, and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Mortgagee shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all charges and expenses altending such proceedings and the execution of his trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
- 8. The Mortgagor further agrees that should this nortgage and the note secured hereby not be eligible for insurance under the National Housing Act within 60 days in from the data hereof (written statement of any officer of the Department of Housing and Urban Development or authorized agent of the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development dated subsequent to the afge- time from the date of this nortgage, declining to inside agent and this mortgage, being deemed Solutionive proof of such necligibility) the Mortgage or the holder of the note may, at its option, declare all same secured hereby insacdiately due and payable.
- 9. The Mortgagor covenants and agrees that so long as this mortgage and the said note secured hereby are insured under the provisions of the National Housing Act, he will not execute or file for record any instrument which imposes a restriction upon the sale or occupancy of the mortgaged property on the basis of race, color, or creed. Upon may violation of this moderaking, the Mortgagee may, at its option, doclare the unpaid balance of the debt secured hereby immediately due and payable.

It is agreed that the Mortgagor shall hold and enjoy the premises above conveyed antil there is a default under this nortgage or in the note secured hereby. It is the true meaning of this instrument that if the Mortgagor shall of this nortgage, and of the note secured hereby, that theh this mortgage shall be utterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. If there is a default in any of the terms, conditions, or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgagoe, all sums then owing by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagoe shall become inmediately and psymble and this mortgage may be foreclosed. The Mortgagor waives the benefit of any appraisement laws of the State of South Carolina. Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgagoe become a party to any suit involving this mortgage or the title to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of an attorney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and expenses (including continuation of abstract) incurred by the Mortgagoe, and a reasonable attorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and payable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgagoe, as a part of the debt secured hereby, and may be recovered and collected hereander.

The covenants berein contained shall bind, and the benefits and advantages shall inure to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular number shall include the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders.
