TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: R. W. Coyle & Betty Coyle

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Bessie Irvin

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all Improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southeastern side of Seyle Street in Dunean Mill Village being shown and designated as Lot 109, Section 4, on plat of Dunean Mill Village recorded in Plat Book S at pages 173-177 and known as house number 4 Seyle Street, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Seyel Street at joint front corner of Lots 109 & 108 and running thence with the line of Lot 108, S 71-40 E 61.7 feet to pin; thence N 02-33 E 58.2 feet to pin on alley; thence with said alley, N 71-57 W 50.8 feet to pin on Seye thence with southeastern side of Seyle Street, S 13-26 W 61.2 feet to the point of beginning.
