All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land containing 3 acres, more or less, situated on the west side of Hammett Road, near Brushy Creek Baptist Church, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having courses and distances according to survey and plat of the property of James W. Moore, by John A. Simmons, Registered Surveyor, dated February 12, 1966, as follows, to wit:
