"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, City of Greenville on the north side of East Earle Street and being known and designated as Lot 14, Section F of Stone Land Company property as shown on a plat thereof recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A at Pages 337 through 345 and having, according to a more recent survey prepared by Dalton & Neves, dated September 1935, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of East Earle Street, said pin being 261.33 feet in a westerly direction from the northwestern corner of the intersection of East Earle and Bennett Streets, and running thence along the north side of East Earle Street, N. 71-20 W. 65.33 feet to a stake in a rock wall; thence through said rock wall, N. 18-30 E. 162.3 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Garraux Street; thence with the south side of Garraux Street, S. 66-15 E. 65.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 18-30 W. 156.2 feet to the point of beginning.
