"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, being in Terra Pines Estates, Section I, lying on the southeast side of Terra Lea and the southeast side of Montero Lane, shown and designated as Lot No. 26 on plat of said subdivision made by Piedmont Engineering Service, December 1958, Revised March 1966, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book PPP, Pages 18 and 19, and having, according to said plat, the following courses and distances, to-Wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Terra Lea at the joint front corner of lots 25 and 26 and running thence along the line of Lot 25, S. 49-49 E. 211.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 39-17 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 27, N. 49-47 W. 213.2 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of Montero Lane; thence with the curve of Montero Lane (the chord being N. 0-22 W. 67.8 feet) to an iron pin; thence still with the curve of Montero Lane and Terra Lea (the chord being N. 41-53 E. 3815 feet) to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Terra Lea (the chord being N. 79-12 E. 46.3 feet) to an iron pin; thence still with the curve of Terra Lea N. 49-25 E. 75.2 feet to the beginning corner.
