Tract B-A certain tract or parcel of real estate located on the left descending bank of Bayou Lafourche, more specifically set forth and designated by the letters I. H. K. J. I. on the attached [thereto] map; said tract or parcel of real estate commencing at Point I, which said Point is located at the intersection of a Southwesterly extension of the Southeasterly line of the hereinabove described Tract A and Bayon Lafourche; thence N. 23° 48′ 30" E., a distance of 56 feet more or less to Point H; being the intersection of said line with the Southwesterly right of way line of the Parish Road which parallels Bayou Lafourche, which said road also forms the Southwesterly boundary of the aforesaid Tract A; thence N. 69° 45′ 30″ W. a distance of 197.6 feet to Point K; thence S. 22° 53′ 30″ W. a distance of 57 feet, more or less, to Bayou Lafourche Point J; thence in a Southeasterly direction along the meander of Bayou Lafourche a distance of 198 feet, more or less, to Point I, the point of beginning, together with all improvements thereon and all rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, advantages, batture, accretion and alluvian thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining; save and except all oil, gas and other minerals.
