NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns the following described piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon:

> ALL that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being near Club View Heights, at the foot of Paris Mountain, in Greenville County, South Carolina, which contains 13.2 acres, more or less, which is the major portion of Tract 8 of the property of the H. W. Batson Estate, which is shown on a plat recorded in Plat Book MM, Page 50, and which is described more particularly according to a revision of that plat dated March 1, 1966, by C. O. Riddle, R.L.S. as follows:
