(heremafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted into FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of NINETEEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 ----- DOLLARS

(\$ 19,150.00), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is 25 years after the date herest, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated beyon by rederence, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may horosafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagee on other or no security.

NOW. KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagen, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums tor which the Mortgager may be indebted to the Mortgager at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgager, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars § \$3.00) to the Mortgager in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgager at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereat is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgager, its successors and assigns.)

"All that certain office, paivel or lot of land, with all impossements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of Santh Carolina, County of Greenville,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate; lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 103, as shown on a plat of Farmington Acres, which plat is of record in the Office of the RMC for Greenville County in Plat Book RR at Pages 106 and 107, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Claxton Drive and the joint front corners of Lots 103 and 104 and running thence with the common line of said lots N. 37-15 W. 150 feet to an iron pih; thence N. 52-45 E. 90 feet to an iron pih; thence S. 37-15 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Claxton Drive; thence with said drive S. 52-45 W. 90 feet to the point of Beginning.

"In addition to and together with the monthly payments of principal and interest under the terms of the note secured hereby, the mortgagor promises to pay to the mortgages for the term of the guaranty policy the sum of 1/48th of 1% of the eriginal amount of this loan in payment of the mortgage guaranty insurance covering this loan and on his failure to pay it, the mortgages may advance it for the mortgager's amount and collect it as part of the debt secured by the mortgage."

"The mortgagors agree that after the expiration of ten years from the date hereof, the mortgage may at its option apply for mortgage insurance for an additional period of five years with the mortgage insurance for an additional period of five years with the mortgage insurance company insuring this team, and the mortgagor agrees to pay to the mortgage as premium for such insurance one half of 1% of the principal balance then existing.

Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaneals, and appurturances to the same belonging or in any willy incident or appertaining, and all of the rests, issues and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting situes and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the hand bequeabout furtility, be considered a part of the real estate.
