22. Release. Upon payment of all sums secured by this Mortgage, this Mortgage shall become null and void, and Lender shall release this Mortgage without charge to Borrower. Borrower shall pay all costs of recording him, if any.

23. Waiver of Homestead. Borrower hereby waives all right of homestead exemption in the Property.
