WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 20 of a subdivision known as Avon Park as shown on plat thereof prepared by C. C. Jones, dated December, 1956 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book KK, at Page 71, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 20 and 48; and running thence along the line of said lots, S. 15-53 W. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 74-07 W. 89.8 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Avon Drive; thence continuing along the eastern side of Avon Drive, N. 15-53 E. 150 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Avon Drive and Sheffield Lane, which intersection is curved, the chord of which is N. 60-53 W. 36.4 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Sheffield Lane; thence along the southern side of Sheffield Lane, S. 74-07 E. 65 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to us by Guy Shore by deed of even date, to be recorded herewith.
