That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whercof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Butler Township, containing 27 acres, more or less, and being on the northern side of Scuffletown Road (or the Woodruff Road), being bounded on the north by lands now or formerly of J. F. Spearman and J. C. Jones; on the east by lands now or formerly of Mrs. Booth; on the south by lands now or formerly of B. E. Butler; on the west by lands now or formerly of Jid Smith; LESS, HOWEVER, two (2) small tracts aggregating four (4) acres, more or less, conveyed away by D. A. Looper to Irving Brabo and Helen Gray Brabo by deed recorded in Deed Book 433, Page 87, and by D. A.
