14. That in the event this mortgage should be foreclosed, the Mortgagor expressly waives the 3-artist of Sections 45-58 through 45-96.1 of the 1962 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended, or any other appears ment laws.

THE MORTGAGEE COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS.

- 1.
