Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at page 119, said lot being known and designated as Lot No. 3 on said recorded plat in Block E and has a frontage of 50 feet on First Avenue or Paris Mountain Road (now knows as Poinsett Highway) and runs back in parallel lines 150 feet to a 10 foot alley, and being 50 feet across the rear.
