NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, at the northwesterly corner of the intersection of Arbutus Trail and Lockwood Avenue, in the City of Greenville, being shown and designated as Lot No. 49 on a plat of SECTION A OF ELLETSON ACRES, made by Woodward Engineering Company, dated September, 1955, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book EE at page 161, and having according to a plat made by R. K. Campbell, Dated April 19, 1961, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northerly side of Arbutus Trail at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 48 and 49 and running thence with the common line of said lots, N. 6-15 W., 211 feet to the center line of the old run of the creek; thence along the center of the old run of the creek, N. 59-42 E., 76.4 feet to an iron pin on the westerly side of Lockwood Avenue; thence with the westerly side of Lockwood Avenue, S. 13-32 E., 179 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Arbutus Trail and Lockwood Avenue, the chord of which is S. 22-34 W., 32.7 feet to an iron pin on the northwesterly side of Arbutus Trail; thence with the northwesterly sode of Arbutus Trail, S. 58-40 W., 84.7 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.



Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
