And, the grantor (s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') heirs or successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee(s) heirs or successors and assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') heirs or successors and against every person womsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. This being the same premises conveyed to the grantor herein by Deed from Ada S. Chandler dated August 28, 1973 and recorded in Deed Book 982 at Page 595 in the RMC Office for Greenville County.
