) Dollars each on the first day of each Omonth hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sconer paid, to be due and payable 30 years after date; and
