

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being at the northwester corner of the intersection of Tamarack Trail and Pennwood Lane near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and known and designated as Lot No. 21 of a subdivision known as Pontana Forest, plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book YY at Page 171 and according to said plat has the following metes and bounds, to-vit:
