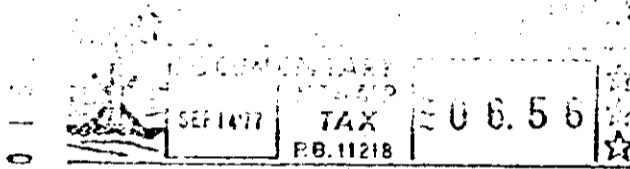

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Oneal Township, near Double Springs Baptist Church, being bounded on the north and east by lands of E. J. Tate, on the south by another one acre lot owned by E. J. Tate, and on the west by the Old Buncombe Road (New Road is State Highway 415) and bieng a part of the 10 acre tract that was conveyed to E. J. Tate by deed from W. A. Clark, December 10, 1929, recorded in the R.M.C.
