NINE AND 33/100 ----- (5 299.33 ) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner 30 vears after date, and paid, to be due and payable

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgages, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable and said holder shall have the right to institute any preceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements the reon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southeastern side of Five Gait Turn, known and designated as Lot No. 152 on a plat of Heritage Lakes Subdivision, by Heanes Engineering Co., Inc. revised October 20, 1977, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 6H at Page 17 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Five Gait Turn, joint corner Lots 152 and 153, and running with the joint line of said Lots, S. 26-38-55 E., 239.32 Geet to an iron pin; thence with the joint line of Lots 152 and 156, N. 82-06-55 E., 188 feet to an iron pin on Lake Horeshoe, thence with the edge of Lake Horseshoe with a traverse line of N. 11-18-36 E. (with the actual property line at the normal water Hevel) 50.99 feet; thence with the joint line of Lots 152 and 151, N. 48-02-10 W., 299.13 feet to an iron pin on Five Gait Turn; thence with the curve of said Five Gait Turn, the chord of which is S. 52-39-27 W., 102.06 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
