(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgage's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Seven and 13/100----
Dollars (\$8, 937.13--) due and payable

on or before January 5, 1979 with interest on the unpaid balance due at maturity to be computed and paid at the rate of Nine (9%) percent per annum

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 9% per contum per annum, to be paid: at maturity.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land located, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as a tract containing 10.07 acres, more or less, as shown on survey entitled "Property of William J. Wirthlin", dated August 31, 1978, prepared by C. O. Riddle, RLS, recorded in the Greenville County R.M.C. Office in Plat Book 6 at Page 90, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of White Road, at the joint front corner of the within tract and other property of the Grantor comprised of a tract containing 24.1212 acres as shown on said plat and running thence with the center of White Road S. 73-59 W., 100 feet to a spike; thence, still with the center of White Road, S. 83-57 W., 100 feet to a spike; thence, still with the center of White Road, S. 89-20 W., 100 feet to a spike; thence, still with White Road, N. 36-12 W., 200 feet to a spike; thence, still with White Road, N. 83-28 W., 100 feet to a spike; thence N. 77-58-30 W., 161.96 feet to an old iron pin in the center of White Road at the joint front corner of the within tract and property now or formerly of Melvin J. Holt; thence, along the line of property now or formerly of Melvin J. Holt; thence, along the line of property now or formerly of Melvin J. Holt N. 25-17 E., 536.6 feet to an old iron pin; thence N. 44-50 E., 595.96 feet to an old iron pin the joint corner of the within tract, a tract containing 25.12 acres, property now or formerly of Dennis E. B. Beason and property now or formerly of Melvin J. Holt; thence, S. 8-10 W., 926 feet to an iron pin in the center of White Road, the point and place of beginning.

This the same property conveyed to the Mortgagors herein by deed of William J. Wirthlin recorded in the Greenville County R.M.C. Office in Deed Book 1088 at Page 395 on the 1990 of September, 1978.

Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual figurehold furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TQ HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premies unto the Mortgagee, its beirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises bereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is 0 lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided berein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

(1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced bereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall be ar interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.

(2) That it will keep the improvements now existing or bereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any other hizards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not less than the mortgage debt, or in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due; and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby anythorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance owing on the Mortgage debt, whether due or not.

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
