(v) To maintain up-to-date day and repeat and take-up reports required by the company under the Securities Act, and to furnish quarterly, annual, semi-annual and other reports required by the company under the Securities Act, and to furnish to the company such other reports as may be required by the company, all in such form and detail as the company may prescribe, and not to withhold in the property, or cause to be withheld, documents, records, contracts, agreements, or other papers, or any part of the written agreement of the Company, and, not to receive or to cause to be received, or to have delivered, any documents, records, or other papers, or any part of the written agreement of the Company, which are not in accordance with the requirements of the Securities Act.

(iii) To comply with all laws, ordinances and regulations affecting the project;

(iv) To pay or reimburse the Government for expenses reasonably necessary and incidental to the performance of the contract, including those funds to be expended in connection with the preparation and presentation of the bid, proposal or offer, and those funds to be expended in connection with the award, administration, inspection, audit, and termination of the project, including those funds to be expended in connection with the preparation, presentation, and defense of claims, disputes, and other instruments, attorney's fees, trustees' fees, court costs, and expenses of defending and prosecuting criminal proceedings.

(12) Neither the prospect, nor any partner thereof, or interest therefrom, nor its agent, associated with the prospect, shall be entitled to dividends or distributions, or otherwise, without the written consent of the Company and the Board of Directors, unless rights so to receive hereunder, including but not limited to the payment of dividends, are specifically granted by the Board of Directors and inserted in the seal hereunto made, and agreed upon by the Company, to the effect hereof.

114. The Government may extend and alter the measures of protection against the importation of the goods referred to in the Government's decree freely, subject to its discretion. In the Government's opinion, it is also the right of the Government to determine the importation of the goods referred to in the Government's decree, and to prohibit the importation of the goods referred to in the Government's decree.

(3) It is the intent of the Congress that the Secretary of the Interior shall administer such production and sales contracts as a Federal land bank, or other responsible corporation or private credit source, at reasonable rates and terms for loans for similar purposes and periods of time. Hereafter will operate the Government's regional office of the Bureau of Land Management and the state and the individual counties and cities for whom such contracts are negotiated, for the purpose of administration with such local offices.
