and we have granted, bargained, sold and released and to them given to do and furnish full and release unto the said

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of
South Carolina, situate, lying and being on the western side of Brook Forest Drive,
being known and designated as Lot No. 11, as shown on a plat of Section 2 Belle Meade,
made by Piedmont Engineering Services, June, 1971, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office
for Greenville County in Plat Book 22, at pages 116 and 117, and having, according to
said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the western side of Brook Forest Drive, said pin being
70 feet from the southwestern intersection of Brook Forest Drive and Williamsburg
Drive; thence S. 36-20 E. 160 feet to an iron pin on the western side of
Brook Forest Drive; thence N. 54-49 W. 25 feet to the point of beginning.
