**MORTGAGE**  
(Construction—Permanent)

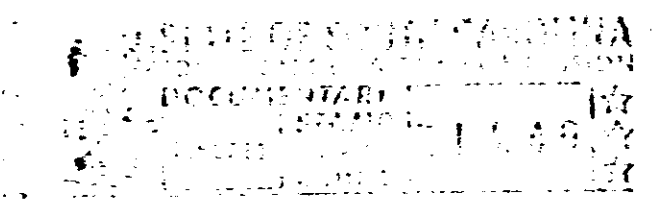
THIS MORTGAGE is made this 28th day of February, 1980, between the Mortgagor, Roy W. Chatman and Mary M. Chatman, (herein "Borrower"), and the Mortgagee, South Carolina Federal Savings and Loan Association, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, whose address is 1500 Hampton Street, Columbia, South Carolina (herein "Lender").

WHEREAS, Borrower is indebted to Lender in the principal sum of Thirty six thousand and 00/100 (\$36,000.00) Dollars or so much thereof as may be advanced, which indebtedness is evidenced by Borrower's note dated February 28, 1980, (herein "Note"), providing for monthly installments of interest before the amortization commencement date and for monthly installments of principal and interest thereafter, with the balance of the indebtedness, if not sooner paid, due and payable on August 1, 2010;

TO SECURE to Lender (a) the repayment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon, the payment of all other sums, with interest thereon, advanced in accordance herewith to protect the security of this Mortgage and the performance of the covenants and agreements of Borrower herein contained, (b) the performance of the covenants and agreements of Borrower contained in a Construction Loan Agreement between Lender and Borrower dated February 28, 1980, (herein "Loan Agreement") as provided in paragraph 24 hereof, and (c) the repayment of any future advances, with interest thereon, made to Borrower by Lender pursuant to paragraph 21 hereof (herein "Future Advances"), Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant, and convey to Lender and Lender's successors and assigns the following described property located in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of the lands now or formerly owned by H. C. Alexander and William Schwiers in the road leading from Cleveland Street and running thence with Schwiers' line S. 45-53 W. 170.3 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Dority's property; thence along the Dority line N. 53-21 W. 100.2 feet, more or less, to a point at the joint rear corner of the property now or formerly owned by Cosby; thence along the Cosby line N. 43-06 E. 189.3 feet to an iron pin on Harvest Lane; thence along said road S.42-35 E. 108.1 feet to the point of beginning.

This being the same property conveyed to the mortgagors herein by deed of Eva Troutman dated April 21, 1976 and recorded in the RMC Office of Greenville County in Deed Book 1035 at Page 98 on April 22, 1976.
